Re: Request for the IAD disciplinary cards of named police officers, the daily activity report (EPPD form 302-1109) for named El Paso police officer for Thursday, 9/16/10 and the full and complete public record of EPPD Case #10-259298

Dear Mr. Almonte:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 442989.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You have released some information, including the two officers' disciplinary cards, and claim the submitted police report may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code. We have considered your arguments and the submitted information and have determined that in accordance with section 552.108(a)(1) you may withhold the submitted information. However, you must release the basic information pursuant to section 552.108(c) of the Government Code. Lastly, because you have not submitted the requested daily activity report, we assume you have released it. *See* Gov't Code §§ 552.301, .302.
