Dear Ms. McClellan:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 449386.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the submitted information may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code. We have considered your arguments and the submitted information and have determined that in accordance with section 552.108(a)(1) you may withhold the submitted 911 calls. To the extent the requested videos exist, we assume you have released them as you have not submitted them to this office. *See* Gov't Code §§ 552.301, .302. Lastly, the rest of the submitted information is not responsive to the request, and this decision does not address it.
