The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 458295.

You claim the submitted probable cause affidavit may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code. We have considered your arguments and the submitted information and have determined that in accordance with section 552.108(a)(1) you may withhold the submitted information. To the extent the requested DIC-24 form exists, we assume you have released it. *See Gov't Code §§ 552.301, .302.*
