Dear Ms. Fleming:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 454779.

The Texas Department of Criminal Justice (the "department") received a request for a list of all absconders in eight counties, including each individual's name, department number, offense, release date, and discharge date. You state you have released or will release some of the requested information to the requestor. You claim the submitted information is excepted from disclosure under sections 552.101 and 552.134 of the Government Code. We have considered the exceptions you claim and reviewed the submitted information.

Section 552.134 of the Government Code is applicable to inmates and former inmates of the department, and provides, in relevant part:

- (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) or by Section 552.029, information obtained or maintained by the [department] is excepted from the requirements of Section 552.021 if it is information about an inmate who is confined in a facility operated by or under a contract with the department.

Gov't Code § 552.134(a). You state the submitted information consists of information about inmates or former inmates who were confined in a facility operated by the department. You further state the exceptions in section 552.029 are not applicable in this instance. Therefore,

we find the submitted information must be withheld under section 552.134 of the Government Code.¹

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
