Dear Mr. Mann:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 460428.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You state you have released Police General Order 10.13 and claim the information marked in red may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code. We have considered your arguments and the submitted information and have determined that in accordance with section 552.108(a)(1) you may withhold the information marked in red. You also claim the information marked in green is excepted from public disclosure pursuant to section 552.130 of the Government Code. We agree you must withhold the information marked in green in accordance with section 552.130.
