Dear Ms. Preusse:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 462910.

The Pflugerville Police Department (the "department") received a request for information pertaining to a specified incident. You state the department has released some of the requested information. You claim the submitted information is excepted from disclosure under section 552.108 of the Government Code. We have considered the exception you claim and reviewed the submitted information.

We note the submitted information was the subject of a previous request by the department for a decision, in response to which this office issued Open Records Letter No. 2012-08384 (2012). You do not indicate there has been any change in the law, facts, and circumstances on which the previous ruling is based. We therefore conclude the department must rely on Open Records Letter No. 2012-08384 as a previous determination and withhold or release the submitted information in accordance with previous ruling. *See* Open Records Decision No. 673 at 6-7 (2001) (listing elements of first type of previous determination under Gov't Code § 552.301(a)).

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
