Dear Ms. Presley:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 460580.

The Frisco Police Department (the "department") received two requests from different requestors for information pertaining to a specified incident. You state you will release some of the requested information to the first requestor. You claim the submitted information is excepted from disclosure under section 552.130 of the Government Code. We have considered the exception you claim and reviewed the submitted information.

Section 552.130 of the Government Code excepts from disclosure information related to a motor vehicle operator's or driver's license or permit issued by an agency of this state or another state or country; a motor vehicle title or registration issued by an agency of this state or another state or country; or a personal identification document issued by an agency of this state or another state or country or a local agency authorized to issue an identification document. Gov't Code § 552.130(a). You seek to withhold the submitted video recordings under section 552.130 because they contain a driver's license number that the department is unable to redact. Upon review, we find the submitted video recordings contain information from a personal identification document issued by another state. You explain the department does not have the technological capability to redact information from the submitted video recordings. Accordingly, the department must withhold the submitted information under section 552.130(a)(3) of the Government Code.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
