Dear Mr. Munoz:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 463068.


The La Joya Independent School District (the "district"), which you represent, received a request for all documents related to the requestor's grievance and the police reports related to a specified investigation. You claim the submitted information is excepted from disclosure under sections 552.108 and 552.135 of the Government Code. We have considered the exceptions you claim and reviewed the submitted information.

We note the submitted information is responsive to a previous request for information from the same requestor. In Open Records Letter No. 2011-03772 (2011), we determined the district must withhold some of the information at issue under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with section 261.201 of the Family Code and release the remaining information. We have no indication there has been any change in the law, facts, or circumstances on which the previous ruling was based. Thus, the district must continue to rely on Open Records Letter No. 2011-03772 as a previous determination and withhold or release the submitted information in accordance with that ruling. *See* Open Records Decision No. 673 (2001) (so long as law, facts, and circumstances on which prior ruling was based have not changed, first type of previous determination exists where requested information is precisely same information as was addressed in prior attorney general ruling, ruling is addressed to same governmental body, and ruling concludes information is or is not excepted from disclosure).

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
