Dear Mr. Daniel:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 477733.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You have released the current eyewitness identification policy and information relating to reassignment of the case and explain you have no videos or information regarding eyewitness identification procedures in effect on May 30, 2012. You claim the submitted handwritten and electronic notes may be withheld from the requestor. We have considered your arguments and the submitted information and have determined that in accordance with section 58.007 of the Family Code, you must withhold the submitted information.
