The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 479828.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. We note you have released the motor vehicle information to the respective requestors to whom the information relates in accordance with section 552.023 of the Government Code. *See* Gov't Code § 552.023 (governmental body may not deny access to person to whom information relates, or that person's representative, solely on grounds that information is considered confidential by privacy principles). We agree you must withhold the motor vehicle record information as marked in accordance with section 552.130 of the Government Code. Also, you may withhold the social security number(s) under section 552.147 of the Government Code.
