Dear Mr. Green:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 480786.

The Lufkin Police Department (the "department") received a request for all information pertaining to a specified automobile accident. You state the department has released some information to the requestor. You claim the submitted information is excepted from disclosure under section 552.130 of the Government Code.¹ We have considered the exception you claim and reviewed the submitted information.

Section 552.130 of the Government Code excepts from public disclosure information relating to a motor vehicle operator's license, driver's license, motor vehicle title or registration issued by an agency of this state or another state or country. *See Gov't Code* § 552.130(a)(1)-(2). The submitted video recordings contain motor vehicle record information that is excepted from disclosure under section 552.130. Because the department states it lacks the technological capability to redact such information from these video recordings, we agree the department must withhold the submitted information in its entirety under section 552.130 of the Government Code.

¹Although you raise section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with section 552.130 of the Government Code, this office has concluded section 552.101 does not encompass other exceptions found in the Act. *See Open Records Decision Nos. 676 at 1-2 (2002), 575 at 2 (1990).*
