Dear Mr. Weir:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 484943 (COSA W012690).

The City of San Antonio (the "city") received a request for information pertaining to a specified incident. You claim that the requested information is excepted from disclosure under section 552.108 of the Government Code. We have considered the exception you claim and reviewed the submitted information.

We note the requested information was the subject of a previous request, as a result of which this office issued Open Records Letter No. 2012-15995 (2012). In the previous ruling, we concluded the city may withhold the requested information under section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code, except for basic information under section 552.108(c), which must be released. Therefore, as you do not indicate there has been any change in the law, facts, and circumstances on which the previous ruling is based, we conclude the city may withhold or release the submitted information in accordance with Open Records Letter No. 2012-15995.¹ See Open Records Decision No. 673 at 6-7(2001) (listing elements of first type of previous determination under Gov't Code § 552301(a)).

¹As we are able to make this determination, we need not address your exception to disclosure.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
