Re: Request for autopsy of a named individual, shot by an Austin police officer on 03/01/13; including all notes, measurements, drawings, photographs taken at the scene; audio and video records related to the incident including the 911 call, any calls or transmissions to any APD officer; also any audio or video recordings from the camera in the responding officer's car, and any audio of the incident; etc.

Dear Ms. Grace:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 488823.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You explain you do not have the requested autopsy report because it has not been completed and claim the submitted information may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code. We have considered your arguments and the submitted information and have determined that in accordance with section 552.108(a)(1) you may withhold the submitted information. However, you must release the basic information pursuant to section 552.108(c) of the Government Code.
