Dear Mr. Galindo:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 485515 (PIR No. 13-35469).

The Office of the Attorney General (the "OAG") received a request for 1) the current contract, amendments, or extensions concerning the Employer Repository Maintenance and Verification project and 2) any performance reports, corrective actions, and audits performed for said project. The OAG has released some information and claims the remainder is excepted from disclosure under section 552.139 of the Government Code. We have considered the exception the OAG claims and reviewed the submitted sample of information.¹

Section 552.139(a) of the Government Code provides:


(a) Information is excepted from [required public disclosure] if it is information that relates to computer network security, to restricted information under Section 2059.055 [of the Government Code], or to the design, operation, or defense of a computer network.

Gov't Code § 552.139(a). The OAG asserts Exhibit B relates to computer network security and therefore is excepted from public disclosure under section 552.139(a). Upon review of the information, we agree Exhibit B relates to computer network security. Thus, the OAG must withhold Exhibit B under section 552.139(a) of the Government Code.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
