Dear Ms. Presley:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 484827.

The Frisco Police Department (the "department") received a request for video recordings related to a specified incident. You claim that the submitted information is excepted from disclosure under section 552.130 of the Government Code. We have considered the exception you claim and reviewed the submitted information.

Section 552.130 of the Government Code provides that information relating to a motor vehicle operator's license, driver's license, motor vehicle title, or registration issued by an agency of this state or another state or country is excepted from public release. Gov't Code § 552.130(a)(1)–(2). You seek to withhold information subject to section 552.130 in the submitted video recordings. You state the department lacks the technical capacity to redact motor vehicle record information from the submitted video recordings. Accordingly, the department must withhold the entirety of the video recording we have indicated under section 552.130. The remaining video recording does not contain any discernable information subject to section 552.130, and it may not be withheld on that basis. As you raise no other exceptions to disclosure, the remaining information must be released.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
