Dear Mr. Meitler:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the “Act”), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 492866 (PIR# 19593).

The Texas Education Agency (the “agency”) received a request for information pertaining to Request for Offer 701-11-030. You indicate you will release some of the requested information to the requestor. Although you take no position with respect to the public availability of the submitted information, you state release of this information may implicate the proprietary interests of Prologic Technical Systems (“Prologic”); Skyward, Inc. (“Skyward”); SunGard Public Sector K-12 (“SunGard”); and Texas Computer Cooperative (“TCC”). Accordingly, you notified Prologic, Skyward, SunGard, and TCC of the request and of their right to submit arguments as to why the submitted information should not be released. *See* Gov’t Code § 552.305(d) (permitting interested third party to submit to attorney general reasons why requested information should not be released); Open Records Decision No. 542 (1990) (statutory predecessor to section 552.305 permitted governmental body to rely on interested third party to raise and explain applicability of exception to disclosure under certain circumstances). We have reviewed the submitted information.


An interested third party is allowed ten business days after the date of its receipt of the governmental body’s notice to submit its reasons, if any, as to why information relating to that party should not be released. *See* Gov’t Code § 552.305(d)(2)(B). As of the date of this letter, we have not received arguments from Prologic, Skyward, SunGard, or TCC. Thus, Prologic, Skyward, SunGard, and TCC have not demonstrated they have a protected proprietary interest in any of the submitted information. *See id.* § 552.110(a)–(b); Open Records Decision Nos. 661 at 5–6 (1999) (to prevent disclosure of commercial or financial

information, party must show by specific factual evidence, not conclusory or generalized allegations, that release of requested information would cause that party substantial competitive harm), 552 at 5 (1990) (party must establish *prima facie* case that information is trade secret), 542 at 3. Accordingly, the agency may not withhold the submitted information on the basis of any proprietary interests Prologic, Skyward, SunGard, or TCC may have in the information. As no exceptions to disclosure have been raised, the submitted information must be released.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
