Dear Ms. Lentz:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 493105.

The Williamson County Sheriff's Office (the "sheriff's office") received a request for a video recording pertaining to a specified automobile accident. You claim the submitted information is excepted from disclosure under section 552.130 of the Government Code. We have considered the exception you claim and reviewed the submitted information.

Section 552.130(a)(2) of the Government Code excepts from public disclosure information relating to a motor vehicle title or registration issued by an agency of this state or another state or country. Gov't Code § 552.130(a)(2). The submitted video recording contains motor vehicle record information that is excepted from disclosure under section 552.130(a)(2). Because the sheriff's office states it lacks the technological capability to redact information from the submitted video recording, we find the sheriff's office must withhold the submitted video recording in its entirety under section 552.130(a)(2) of the Government Code. *See* Open Records Decision No. 364 (1983).

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.
