Dear Ms. Villarreal:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 500608 (City Reference No. LGL 13-525).

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the submitted information may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code. We have considered your arguments and the submitted information and have determined that in accordance with section 552.108(a)(1) you may withhold the submitted information. However, you must release the basic information from report numbers 13-8367, 13-8368, and 13-8369 pursuant to section 552.108(c) of the Government Code. Also, you must withhold the marked motor vehicle record information under section 552.130 of the Government Code and may withhold the social security numbers under section 552.147 of the Government Code.
