Dear Ms. Russell:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 508291.


The Euless Police Department (the "department") received a request for information concerning a specified motor vehicle collision. The department released some of the information responsive to the request. However, as permitted by section 552.130(c) of the Government Code, the department redacted information it determined to be subject to section 552.130(a) of the Government Code without requesting a decision from this office. *See Gov't Code* § 552.130(c). Pursuant to section 552.130(d), the requestor has asked this office to review the information and render a decision as to whether this information is exempted from disclosure under section 552.130(a) of the Government Code. We have considered the position and reviewed the information.

Section 552.130 of the Government Code exempts from disclosure information relating to a motor vehicle operator's or driver's license or permit and a motor vehicle title or registration issued by an agency of this state or another state or country. *Id.* § 552.130(a). Accordingly, the department must withhold the information you marked under section 552.130 of the Government Code.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
