Dear Ms. Anderson-Nelson:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 516447 (ORR#10413).

Dallas Area Rapid Transit ("DART") received a request for the report concerning a specified incident. DART released most of the information responsive to the request. However, as permitted by section 552.130(c) of the Government Code, DART redacted information it determined to be subject to section 552.130(a) of the Government Code without requesting a decision from this office. *See* Gov't Code § 552.130(c)-(e). Pursuant to section 552.130(d), the requestor has asked this office to review the information and render a decision as to whether this information is excepted from disclosure under section 552.130 of the Government Code. We have considered the position and reviewed the information.

Section 552.130 of the Government Code excepts from disclosure information relating to a motor vehicle operator's or driver's license or permit and a motor vehicle title or registration issued by an agency of this state or another state or country. *Id.* § 552.130(a)(1), (2). Accordingly, DART must withhold the information you redacted, and the additional information we marked, under section 552.130 of the Government Code.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
