Re: Request for five categories of information pertaining to the death of a named individual on or about October 28, 2013

Dear Ms. Allen:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 523694 (NJDHS File No. 65246).

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You explain you do not have information responsive to the first three requested items, have sought clarification of the request for the policy and training manual, and claim the submitted information may be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code on behalf of a law enforcement agency with a law enforcement interest. Further, you inform this office the law enforcement agency objects to the disclosure of the information because it relates to an ongoing criminal case and release would interfere with the case. Thus, we conclude you may withhold the submitted information pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1).
