Dear Ms. Crow:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 522400.


The City of Sugar Land (the "city") received a request for information pertaining to the redevelopment of Settlers Way Park. The city claims the requested information is excepted from disclosure under section 552.101 of the Government Code. We have considered the claimed exception and reviewed the submitted information.

Section 552.101 of the Government Code excepts from disclosure "information considered to be confidential by law, either constitutional, statutory, or by judicial decision." Gov't Code § 552.101. This section encompasses information protected by other statutes. Section 191.004(b) of the Natural Resources Code provides, "Information specifying the location or nature of an activity covered by a permit or an application for a permit under this chapter is not public information." Nat. Res. Code § 191.004(b). You assert the submitted information reveals the location and nature of an activity covered by a permit or application for a permit under chapter 191 of the Natural Resources Code. Based on your representations and our review, we agree the information at issue is within the scope of section 191.004(b). Therefore, the city must withhold the submitted information under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with section 191.004(b) of the Natural Resources Code.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
