Dear Mr. McKinney:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 532760 (Montgomery File No. 14PIA0241).

The Montgomery County Sheriff's Office (the "sheriff's office") received a request for video recordings pertaining to a specified incident. You claim the requested information is exempted from disclosure under section 552.130 of the Government Code. We have considered the exception you claim and reviewed the submitted representative sample of information.¹

Section 552.130 of the Government Code exempts from disclosure information that relates to a motor vehicle title or registration issued by an agency of this state or another state or country. Gov't Code § 552.130(a)(2). The submitted information consists of video recordings containing images of discernable license plates subject to section 552.130 of the Government Code. You state the sheriff's office lacks the technological capability to redact this information from the recordings. Based on these representations, we agree the sheriff's

office must withhold the submitted video recordings in their entirety under section 552.130 of the Government Code. *See* Open Records Decision No. 364 (1983).

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
