Dear Ms. Campbell:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 529530.

The Leander Police Department (the "department") received a request for information pertaining to a specified call for service number. You state you have released some information. You claim the submitted audio recording is excepted from disclosure under section 552.130 of the Government Code. We have considered the exception you claim and reviewed the submitted information.

Section 552.130 of the Government Code provides information relating to a motor vehicle operator's license, driver's license, motor vehicle title or registration, or personal identification document issued by an agency of this state or another state or country is excepted from public release. *See* Gov't Code § 552.130. Upon review, we determine the department must withhold the audible motor vehicle record information in the submitted audio recording under section 552.130 of the Government Code. You claim the department lacks the technical capability to redact the section 552.130 information from the audio recording. However, because the department had the ability to copy the audio recording in order to submit the requested information for our review, we believe the department has the capability to produce a copy of only the non-confidential portions of the submitted audio recording. Therefore, we find the department must withhold the audible motor vehicle record information in the audio recording under section 552.130 of the Government Code.

The department may not withhold any portion of the remaining information in the submitted audio recording under section 552.130 and must release the remaining portion of the submitted audio recording.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
