Dear Ms. Presley:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 539346 (Ref. No. P000687-072814).

The City of Frisco (the "city") received a request for information pertaining to a specified investigation. The city states it will release some of the requested information upon payment, but claims some of the submitted information is excepted from disclosure under section 552.130 of the Government Code. We have considered the claimed exception and reviewed the submitted information.

The requested information consists of video recordings taken by a city police officer during his investigation of an accident between an automobile and a motorcycle. You assert some of this information is not responsive to the request for information because it refers to "another individual's license plate and driver's license." However, upon review we find all of the submitted is responsive to the request because it pertains to the specified investigation. Accordingly, we will address your arguments against disclosure of this information under the Act.


Section 552.130 of the Government Code provides information relating to a motor vehicle operator's license, driver's license, motor vehicle title or registration, or personal identification document issued by an agency of this state or another state or country is excepted from public release. *See Gov't Code § 552.130.* The submitted video recordings

contain motor vehicle record information that is subject to section 552.130. The city states it lacks the technical capability to redact the information subject to section 552.130 from the video recordings. Based on this representation, we agree the city must withhold the submitted video recordings in their entirety under section 552.130.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
