Dear Ms. Rutherford:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 545254.

The Jersey Village Police Department (the "department") received a request for information pertaining to a specified incident. You state the department has released some of the requested information. You claim some of the submitted information is excepted from disclosure under section 552.130 of the Government Code. We have considered the exception you claim and reviewed the submitted information.

Section 552.130 of the Government Code provides information relating to a motor vehicle operator's license, driver's license, motor vehicle title or registration, or personal identification document issued by an agency of this state or another state or country is excepted from public release. *See* Gov't Code § 552.130. Upon review, we agree the submitted audio recording in Exhibit B contains motor vehicle record information. You state the department lacks the technological capability to redact the confidential information in the audio recording. Nevertheless, because the department had the ability to copy the submitted audio recording in order to submit the requested information for our review, we believe the department has the capacity to produce a copy of only the non-confidential portions of the recording. Therefore, the department must withhold the information you have indicated in the audio recording in Exhibit B, and the information we have marked in the submitted

report, under section 552.130 of the Government Code. *See* Open Records Decision No. 364 (1983). The remaining information must be released.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
