Re: Request for a copy of a theft report from 2010 involving named individual and any additional information regarding named individual from 2010 to present; Plano ORR #MCC012816

Dear Ms. Henry:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 606561.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. To the extent the specified, requested file number 12046870 exists, we assume you have released it. *See* Gov't Code §§ 552.301, .302. You claim the information must be withheld from the requestor. A request to compile an individual's criminal history implicates this person's privacy. We have concluded such a compilation is highly embarrassing information and is generally not of legitimate concern to the public. Therefore, to the extent you maintain law enforcement records depicting the named individual as a suspect, arrestee, or criminal defendant, you must withhold the information under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy.
