Dear Ms. White:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 608966.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the marked information must be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.130 of the Government Code. We agree you must withhold the marked motor vehicle record information in accordance with section 552.130 of the Government Code. You must also withhold the dates of birth of public citizens you have marked pursuant to section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy. *Paxton v. City of Dallas*, No. 03-13-00546-CV, 2015 WL 3394061, at *3 (Tex. App.—Austin May 22, 2015, pet. denied) (mem. op.). Lastly, you must withhold the personal e-mail address you have marked under section 552.137 of the Government Code, unless the owner affirmatively consents to its public disclosure.
