Re: Request for 7 categories of information regarding eight-liners including any law, ordinance or resolution whereby your governmental body authorizes the issuance of permits to businesses for the display or usage eight-liner machines on a business premise; etc.

Dear Mr. Davis:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 612722.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. We agree you must withhold the marked motor vehicle record information in accordance with section 552.130 of the Government Code. Also, you may withhold the social security number(s) under section 552.147 of the Government Code. Lastly, for any living persons' dates of birth contained in the submitted information, you must withhold them pursuant to section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy. *Paxton v. City of Dallas*, No. 03-13-00546-CV, 2015 WL 3394061, at *3 (Tex. App.—Austin May 22, 2015, pet. denied) (mem. op.).
