Dear Mr. Davis:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 613328.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the video recording must be withheld from the requestor in its entirety pursuant to section 552.130 of the Government Code because you lack the technological capability to redact the motor vehicle record information not pertaining to the requestor from the recording. Thus, we agree you must withhold the video recording in accordance with section 552.130 of the Government Code. The submitted photographs are not responsive to the request, and this ruling does not address them.
