The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 635227.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the submitted probable cause affidavit and narrative information marked as section 552.108 may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code. We have considered your arguments and the information and have determined that in accordance with section 552.108(a)(1) you may withhold some of this marked information. However, you must release a detailed description of the offense from the narrative as basic information pursuant to section 552.108(c). The remaining submitted information is not responsive, and this ruling does not address it.
