Opinion No. O-2480-A
Re: Construction of H. B.
No. 933, Acts 46th Leg.,
Rural Aid Equalization
Law.

We are in receipt of your letter of September 6,
1940, submitting additional questions concerning the sub-
ject matter of our Opinion No. O-2480.

Question 3(c) reads as follows:

"(c) Since in Section 12 of House Bill
933 it is provided that free time is to be
increased if the total appropriation is in-
sufficient to pay all claims for high school
tuition and since it is provided also that
transportation is in like manner to be re-
duced so as to bring the total grants for
aid within the total appropriation therefor,
are the actual amounts received from the
state for tuition and transportation to be
computed as receipts instead of the paper
calculated earned amounts?"

It is our opinion that in determining need for
transportation aid, only the actual amount of tuition re-
ceived should be considered as a receipt.

Please submit an additional explanation of the re-
maining questions. If we understand your alternative questions
3(a) and 3(b), neither method of calculation would be used un-
der Opinion No. O-2480.
