Re: Authority of the Board of Insurance
Commissioners to pay traveling ex-
penses incurred by Assistant Attor-
neys General in performing work for
the Board.

Dear Sir:

You have asked the following question which I quote
from your letter:

"Is Attorney General Opinion No. O-2258
(1940) still in force and effect, providing
for payment of traveling expenses and accounts
incurred by Assistant Attorneys General in
connection with the performance of work for
other State Departments as payable out of the
appropriations made to such other State Depart-
ments?"

We have re-examined Attorney General Opinion No.
O-2258 (1940) and we do not find any subsequent legislation,
decisions, or opinions of this office that would reverse or
modify the conclusion reached in the opinion in any way.
Therefore, you are advised that Attorney General Opinion No.
O-2258 (1940) is still in force and effect, a copy of which
we are enclosing.
