Re: Whether the Beeville-Bee County  
Redevelopment Authority Corporation is  
subject to the Open Meetings Act, Gov't  
Code ch. 551 (ID# 38963)

Dear Mr. Morrill:

You ask whether the Beeville-Bee County Redevelopment Authority Corporation is subject to the Open Meetings Act, Gov't Code ch. 551. The articles of incorporation submitted with your request state that the Beeville-Bee County Redevelopment Authority Corporation was created pursuant to the Development Corporation Act of 1979, V.T.C.S. art. 5190.6.<sup>1</sup> Section 11(b) of the Development Corporation Act of 1979 provides that the board of directors of a corporation created under the act is subject to the Open Meetings Act. Therefore, we conclude that the board of directors of the Beeville-Bee County Redevelopment Authority Corporation is subject to the Open Meetings Act.

S U M M A R Y

The board of directors of the Beeville-Bee County Redevelopment Authority Corporation is subject to the Open Meetings Act, Gov't Code ch. 551, by virtue of section 11(b) of the Development Corporation Act of 1979, V.T.C.S. art. 5190.6.
