ANN. art. 21.49-1, §10 (Vernon 1981)

Dear General Morales:

On July 29, 1991, the State Board of Insurance received a request from Bradford M. Condit for the "registration statements" of Texas Employers' Insurance Association and Employers' Casualty Company filed under article "21.49-1, §8.02(3)." Article 21.49-1 of the Insurance Code contains no §8.02(3). In a subsequent telephone call, Mr. Condit stated that his request encompassed information filed under TEX. INS. CODE ANN. art. 21.49-1, §3 (Vernon 1981). Material filed under §3 of article 21.49-1 is expressly made confidential under the provisions of TEX. INS. CODE ANN. art. 21.49-1, §10 (Vernon 1981). Therefore, the requested material is exempt from disclosure under the Open Records Act, TEX. REV. CIV. STAT. ANN. art. 6252-17a, §3(a)(1) (Vernon Supp. 1991).

The State Board of Insurance requests that you provide the agency with a formal opinion that all material filed pursuant to article 21.49-1, §10 is confidential by law and therefore exempt from disclosure under §3(a)(1) of the Open Records Act. A copy of Mr. Condit's request is enclosed for your reference. The agency will forward copies of representative samples of the requested material for the Opinion Committee's determination.
