Re: Recent Changes in Ethic Laws

Dear Sirs:

Article 6252-92 was recently amended by adding a new section 7A. Subsection (a) provides that a member of the governing body or executive head of a regulatory agency may not, within two years of leaving such position, make any communication to or appearance before an officer or employee of the agency on behalf of a person in connection with any matter on which the person seeks official action.

Does this prohibit an ex-board member from serving as a polygraph intern's sponsor, because to so serve would require the ex-board member to first apply to the Board and communicate to or appear before the Board on behalf of the polygraph intern applicant?

For your resource, I have enclosed a copy of the Texas Polygraph Examiners Act and the Board's Rules and Regulations, a copy of the Board's internship application (including sponsor pages) and a copy of the Board's sixty day report form.
