Dear Representative Junell:


I enclose a copy of a letter dated January 11, 1996 signed by Jack E. Crump as Executive Director of the Texas Commission on Jail Standards, reminding Mayor Kelso of the inspection scheduled for February 6, 1996 and giving notice that Mr. Crump will discuss the matter with the Commissioners at a meeting in Austin on January 26, 1996. While Mr. Crump's letter is dated prior to your discussion with him on January 12, 1996, the envelope forwarding the letter bears a postmark date of January 16, 1996. I also enclose a copy of the envelope for your reference.

Mr. Crump's letter further underscores the need to obtain confirmation of Mr. Crump's agreement with you to postpone the inspection of the Eden Detention Center and to postpone consideration of TCJS's supervision of EDC until an opinion of the Attorney General concerning this matter can be requested and obtained.

On January 17, 1996 I FAX'd to your office a proposed letter drafted by Mary Wolf, an attorney in Ed Small's firm, addressing this issue. If you did not receive the letter, if you have any questions or comments regarding the letter, or if I may be of any assistance to you, please call me.
