RE: REQUEST FOR ATTORNEY GENERAL'S OPINION REGARDING COUNTY RIGHT-OF-WAYS

Dear Attorney General Cornyn:

As the State Representative for Martin County, and Chairman of the House Committee on Land and Resource Management, I have been asked to seek the opinion of your office regarding county right-of-ways.

In Martin County, the county commissioners allow oil companies to run temporary water lines along the county right-of-ways. Individual landowners have protested, asserting that the county does not have the right to use their right-of-ways for this purpose. The landowners would prefer to negotiate with the oil companies individually, but have agreed to abide by the attorney general's opinion.

In addition, the commissioners would like to know whether or not the county's use of the right-ofway would apply to prescription roads.
