According to the statute, "the judicial fund is created in a separate fund in the state treasury to be administered by the comptroller. The fund shall be used only for court-related purposes for the support of the judicial branch of this state."

Specifically, the Harris County Civil Courts would like to know if the judicial maintenance fund can be used to offset a statutory probate court's reduction in funding by the county commissioners' court.

Dear Senator Jackson,

Judge Rory Olsen is requesting an opinion from the Attorney General's office. Here is the question that he would like to be asked of them:

A judicial maintenance fund for the statutory probate courts is created by § 21.006 of the Texas Government Code, which states "The judicial fund is created in a separate fund in the state treasury to be administered by the comptroller. The fund shall be used only for court-related purposes for the support of the judicial branch of this state".

The following sections of the Texas Government Code deal with the sources of the judicial funds: § 25.0016- Excess Contributions, § 51.702- Additional Fees and Costs in Certain Statutory County Courts, and § 51.704- Additional Fees in Statutory County Courts.

If the commissioners court of a county in which there is a statutory probate court reduce the statutory probate court's budget, may funds from the judicial maintenance fund be used to offset the reduction in funding?
