Montrose Counseling Center, Boat People S.O.S., and the Office of the Attorney General are the sponsoring agencies for this training. The day will consist of two different training components.

The morning will begin with the CVC Advanced Track training. This is an overview of the Compensation program with an emphasis on the awards process. This is an advanced course and is best suited for those advocates that provide detailed follow-up with victims on payments as well as suitable training for service providers to better understand billing requirements. Bill processing and benefit payments including: medical; funeral; loss of wages; loss of support; rent/relocation; and all other payment types and necessary documentation will be discussed.

The afternoon will conclude with training on the Address Confidentiality Program, an OAG administered program for family violence, sexual assault, and stalking victims.

- There is **no registration fee** for this training.
- Workshops cover compensation and eligibility components. Handouts will be provided.
- The training will be held at the Montrose Counseling Center, 401 Branard St., Houston, TX 77006.
